The Program Committee continued the adult literature series with this year's topic being "Living In Maine." In response to our Friends' survey the presentations were held twice on Sunday afternoons and twice on Wednesday evenings. Presenters this year included Maine authors Steve Bither, discussing his humorous book about the curiosities in the state of Maine; retired Maine game warden John Ford shared his tales of the life of a game warden; Jim Nelson, maritime historian continued the series and Jennifer Wixon, farmer and Quaker minister conclude the series discussing her Sovereign series about life in a small agricultural community.

The children's program was a visit from *Wind Over Wings*, a bird rescue sanctuary in Dresden, Maine. Over 350 children and adults attended this wonderful program to see and learn about an eagle, a raven, a peregrine and an owl. The program was enthusiastically received by all.
